

BAS ECO GUIDELINES

Bas Production has implemented and communicated company ECO Guidelines. These guidelines must be followed by the teams and employees in the office and on set. The intention is to implement and follow the guidelines through all our teams and on all of the company levels. The guidelines are updated yearly.

ENERGY

Our office spaces use an energy supplier which uses only CO2 free energy. We give preference to devices with accumulators (rechargeable batteries) and/or rechargeable batteries. Our technical teams have been made aware of reducing energy consumption (lights, equipment) and of good practices for limiting consumption.

MANAGING WASTE

Our office staff and production team must follow the strict etiquette of sorting the waste that is used in Slovenia. Waste is sorted into glass, organic waste, paper, plastic packaging and other.

LIMITED USE OF PAPER/PAPERLESS OFFICE

Preference is given to electronic documents, where printing cannot be avoided we print on both sides and black and white. We have switched to paperless document exchanges as far as possible for the distribution of creative documents, scripts, statement of intent and PPM booklets.

ACCOMODATION

Members of the team who do not live locally are provided with accommodation that is as close as possible to the filming location. Preference has been given to eco-friendly accommodation.

CASTING

The casting location and choice of model have been defined to minimise journeys.

STYLING AND MAKEUP

Insofar as possible, the products used are reused, hired, rented or purchased second-hand. In the case of manufacturing, natural materials and local manufacture are selected. Use of disposable products (wipes, sprays, individually portioned products) is minimised in favour of products that are reusable, recycled or that can be recycled, and that generate little waste (terry towel, cotton, etc.). The clothing chosen favours rental over purchase whenever possible. We take into consideration the life cycle: reduce, re-use, recycle. At the end of the shoot the clothes we either: recover them for a next shooting, sell them to the entourage or to vintage stores, are entrusted to organisations that recycle them, or are donated to charities. When possible, we use cosmetics that are labelled organic, at least concerning creams, lotions and cleansing milks. In all cases, use paraben-free beauty products. We use recyclable and/or recycled containers, recycle packaging.

SET

The construction, disassembly, sorting and recycling of waste is considered at the point of designing the set. We give preference to local material and labour. The teams or service providers are instructed to ensure that leftover materials are recovered and recycled. The teams are also made aware of the sorting policy. Items that can be reused for another production are identified and sold to the teams; an association; a local organisation. The preferred option is to hire or reuse items rather than buy or build them. We encourage limiting waste and over-consumption of consumables (gaffers, grips, straps, ropes, etc.) and promote reusing and recycling them. Regarding special effects, we use the least harmful products where possible and ensure that all precautions are taken to prevent damage to human and animal health and the environment.

LOGISTIC

Video-conferencing is the preferred approach in place of in-person meetings. We encourage the use of a car-sharing system that is in place within the team. Transport is shared also for the clients. We prioritise the use of vehicles that can transport the maximum number of people (minibus, monospace, etc.) and regularly check that the car has been well maintained. We optimise routes, taking into account the distance in km and fuel used, and adopting an eco-centric approach to driving.

CATERING

The needs are precisely estimated before the start of the project and the purchase in large packages is favoured. The necessary quantities are planned with accuracy. The leftovers of the day are given to the members of the shoot who wish it. Food purchased is locally sourced as much as possible. Recyclable or reusable cutlery and dishes must be used on set. The coffee machines with single-use pots are not used on set. Sorting bins are installed around the control table: display the "sort your waste" signage. Organic waste is collected and revalorized.
